CARLTON COUNTY RESIDENTIAL USE ONLY

NO BUSINESS RECYCLABLES

ALUMINUM CANS

Rinse and flatten.

GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES

Bottles and jars only.

Rinse, remove caps and rings.

MIXED PAPER

Newspaper, office, computer, colored paper, envelopes, junk mail, and glossy inserts.

NO carbon paper, no gift wrap, no tissue paper, no plastic wrapping, no bound books or spiral notebooks.

SHREDDED PAPER

MUST BE BAGGED. Place in MIXED PAPER bin.

MAGAZINES

Place in MAGAZINE bins.

No books.

PLASTICS:

Bottles, jars, jugs, and tubs only.

Rinse, remove caps.

Flatten if possible.

TIN AND METAL CANS

Rinse.

CARDBOARD & BOXBOARD

MUST BE FLATTENED AND CLEAN.

Corrugated cardboard.

Boxboard (cereal, pasta, cracker boxes, etc.)

Brown paper bags and egg cartons.

NO pizza boxes, wax boxes, foil, plastic laminated boxes, or milk cartons.

Place in brown paper bag on shelf.

PLASTICS: Bottles, jars, jugs, and tubs.

TIN AND METAL CANS

Please respect the unstaffed recycling centers.

- All recyclables must be placed in their proper containers.
- Do not leave bags of unsorted recyclables.
- It is illegal to leave trash at any county recycling center.
