EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1, 2023

- **CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION** waste accepted **WEDNESDAYS FOR \$8** per cubic yard; \$16 per cubic any other day.
- **MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$10** per cubic yard for bagged household garbage
- **MINIMUM CHARGE OF \$16** for mixed waste (un-bagged) and large bulky items. **MIXED WASTE NOT ACCEPTED ON WEDNESDAYS.**
- Requesting patrons **SORT THEIR LOADS BEFORE** arriving at the Transfer Station.
- **NO CHARGE FOR SCRAP METAL** if your load is sorted before you arrive at the Transfer Station.
- The change to minimum charges is to encourage less trips and traffic to the Transfer Station.

CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION

MINIMUM CHARGE
\$8 PER CUBIC YARD
ON WEDNESDAYS
\$16 PER CUBIC
ANY OTHER DAY

Carpet and padding, toilets, ceramic tile, fiberglass, insulation, siding, Styrofoam, roofing materials, plaster, gypsum board, wood, plywood, glass, construction site plastic, metal (anything else attached to a building).

BAGGED HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

\$10 PER
CUBIC YARD

Bagged garbage generated by a household or a business. Does not include recyclables, construction or demolition, large bulky items, electronics, appliances, batteries, fluorescent bulbs, hazardous waste, tires, yard waste, scrap metal, etc.

MIXED WASTE UN-BAGGED GARBAGE, LARGE BULKY ITEMS

\$16 PER
CUBIC YARD

Loads not bagged or loads that have not been sorted, large bulky items (couches, chairs, any item that can't be bagged) **NOT ACCEPTED WEDNESDAYS.**

The cashier has the right to weigh any load. Asphalt, concrete, brick, shingles and loads larger than 9 cubic yards will always be weighed. Bagged waste will be charged \$99.46 per ton and mixed waste will be charged \$154.11 per ton. Demo will be charged \$62.74 per ton Wednesdays only. No hazardous waste, including no asbestos.
