NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN: That a Presidential Nomination Primary Election will be held in all precincts of Carlton County on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. **Polls will be open at 7:00 a.m. and remain open to 8:00 p.m. except for the following: Eagle Township and Lakeview Township will open at 8:00 a.m. and remain open until 8:00 p.m.**

The voter is choosing a candidate for their party to nominate as the candidate to be placed on the 2024 General Election Ballot.

Presidential Nomination Primary voters must request the ballot of the major political party for whose candidate the individual wishes to vote. Polling place election judges must record in the polling place roster the name of the major political party whose ballot the voter requested. The county auditor must include the name of the major political party whose ballot the voter requested with the voting history of the nomination primary election.

The major political party ballot selected by a nomination primary voter is private data, except it will be shared with the chairs of the major political parties in the State of Minnesota.
