

Carlton County Transportation

Adopt-a-Highway Terms and Conditions

The Group Agrees To:

1. Pick up litter on a segment of roadway selected in consultation with Carlton County Transportation. Recommended length is two miles. At the County's discretion, certain roadways may not be eligible.
2. Review the safety training materials before each pickup to alert participants to the hazards and precautions of working on a road right-of-way.
3. Pick up litter during daylight hours only. Pickups may not be allowed at certain times such as on or near holidays.
4. Provide adequate supervision to participants eighteen years of age or younger. Unless specifically permitted, children eleven or younger shall not participate.
5. Limit their work to the area between the outer shoulders and the right-of-way boundary. Participants shall not pick up litter on the roadway itself.
6. Obtain bags & vests from the Transportation Department during regular business hours before each scheduled outing.
7. Place filled trash bags in one of these designated areas: 1. Carlton County Garage in Barnum, 3888 County Rd 61, or the Carlton Transportation Facility, 1630 County Rd 61, Carlton or 2. On the shoulder slope of the road picked, near the ditch bottom. Groups are encouraged to recycle appropriate materials for their own benefit.
8. Call the office of the Transportation Department to request full-bag pickup or to report that roadway has been cleaned.

The County Transportation Department Agrees To:

1. Provide high visibility vests, trash bags, safety information and traffic warning signs when necessary as determined by the County.
2. Arrange to remove filled trash bags from the adopted highway.
3. Arrange to remove large, heavy or hazardous material from the adopted highway.
4. Erect a highway sign or otherwise recognize the group's clean-up efforts. Highway signs shall be erected only for groups that agree to adopt a two mile stretch of blacktopped roadway for a minimum of two years. The name on the sign shall be limited to two lines of twenty characters (including spaces). Carlton County reserves the right to approve and/or edit names or acronyms.
